

BUK EXPELS 81 STUDENTS

Bayero University has expelled a total of eighty one (81) students after being found guilty of examination malpractice.

According to a letter signed by the Acting Director, Academic Affairs, Fatima Binta Mohammed, the Senate at its 304th meeting held on Wednesday 20th June, 2012 considered the submission from the Senate Committee on Examination and Leakages through the Senate Business Committee (SBC) and approved their expulsion from the University.

According to the letter, the students were **expelled** in accordance with Part 19 (17) Aiii of the General Academic and Examination Regulations.

Take-Off Of The General Entrepreneurship Courses

This is to inform the University community that all faculties are expected to integrate the two general Entrepreneurship courses in the list of mandatory courses. The courses are:

i- In order to accommodate the uniqueness of each faculty, it was decided that the two courses shall be taught as follows:

a) Second Semester Level 300 (EEP:3201) and First Semester Level 400 (EEP 4201)

- i. Arts and Islamic Studies
- ii. Social and Management Sciences
- iii. Engineering
- iv. Education – with the exception of Library Science Students who will take the two courses at Level 400.

b) First Semester Level 400 (EEP:3201) & Second Semester Level 400 (EEP:4201)

- i. Faculty of Science
- ii. Law

c) Second Semester Level 300 (EEP:3201) & First Semester Level 500 (EEP:4201)

- i. Faculty of Agriculture

d) Second Semester Level 400 (EE: 3201) & First Semester Level 500 (EEP: 4201)

- i. Medicine
- ii. Dentistry

It should be noted that, in the computation of students' results, the courses are to be imputed as Levels 300 & 400 courses even though the levels at which the courses are taught varies from one faculty to another.
