## BUK's Nasiru Fagge Elected ASUU President

Dr. Nasiru Isa Fagge of the Physics Department has been elected as the new President of the Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU).

In a press release issued by the Union, Dr. Fagge was elected at the end of its 17th National Delegates Conference held at the University of Abuja from 31<sup>st</sup> May to 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2012.

The new ASUU President, who succeeded Professor Ukachukwu Awuzie, becomes the second person in BUK to head the Union, after the former Vice Chancellor and INEC Chairman, Professor Attahiru Jega, held sway between 1987 and 1993 during the military regime of Ibrahim Badamasi Babangida.

Dr. Nasiru Isa Fagge was the immediate Vice President of the Union before his election as the new President. He held various positions in the Union to include Vice Chairman and Chairman of BUK branch, as well as the Zonal Coordinator between 2003 and 2008.

## **Microbiology, Plant Science, Applied Biology and Applied Zoology Get New HODs**

The Vice Chancellor's approval followed the receipt of their nomination and subsequent consultations.

According to the letters, all their appointments took effect from June 4, 2012 for two years.



## Online Registration Commences June 11

The University Senate at its 303<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2012 approved 11<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2012 as dates for the commencement of online registration for both fresh and returning students.

## The 2012/2013 Promotion Exercise

1) In View of the 2012/2013 promotion exercise, the Heads of Department/Unit are hereby called to forward their submissions for the Annual Promotion of Senior Staff. Heads of Department/Unit should ensure the following:

- a) That there are vacancies to which staff are to be recommended for promotion in line with approved 2012/2013 budgetary provisions;
- b) That staff should have served for three years in the position by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2012 and appointment duly confirmed;
- c) That staff were not promoted within the last three years;
- d) That cases of administrative staff in various faculties/departments should be routed through the Registry Departmental Appointments, Promotions and General Purposes Committee;
- e) That cases of Store Officers in various faculties/departments should be routed through the Bursary Department;
- f) That cases of Librarians and Library Officers in various faculties/departments should be

routed through the University Library;

- g) Staff on approved Study Fellowship could be promoted up to the rank of Lecturer I or its equivalent, provided that he/she would not be promoted twice in one study Fellowship period.
  - h) The submissions should strictly be based on the extant promotion guidelines for the appropriate cadre.
- 2) HODs and Units should note that upgrading from the position of Graduate Assistant or its equivalent to Assistant Lecturer or its equivalent in the academic cadre requires the acquisition of a high degree and is processed administratively. So also from Assistant Lecturer to Lecturer II, where a Ph.D is the requirement. The same applies to the upgrading of Registrars appointed to the rank of Lecturer II in the Clinical Departments of the Faculty of Medicine where the Postgraduate Medical Fellowship is required for upgrading to Lecturer I.
- 3) Departments/Units are therefore advised to forward **seventeen copies (17)** of their submission to the Directorate of Personnel Affairs not later than **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2012.**
- 4) It should be noted that only two (2) Salary Structures exist in the



system: CONUASS (01 – 07) for Academic Staff and CONTISS (01 – 15) for Senior Administrative, Professional and Technical Staff across the cadres.
