

BUK Receives Committee On Needs Assessment On Nigerian Universities

The Committee on Needs Assessment on Nigerian Universities paid a courtesy visit on the Vice Chancellor on Wednesday.

The Chairman of the committee, Professor Haruna Abdullahi Birniwa, from Usman Danfodiyo University, said they were in the University to explore areas that needed intervention by the TETFund for better funding.

Prof. Birniwa said three Universities were nominated by the TETFund; the Kano State University of Science and Technology, Wudil, Umaru Musa Yar'adua University, Katsina and Bayero University, Kano.

The Committee Chairman stressed that the committee was mandated to visit all the three Universities nominated in order to see areas where TETFund could intervene.

He said they would assess the physical facilities, such as lecture theaters, studios, laboratories and staff

offices. They would also assess students' enrolment, staff strength and sporting facilities.

Professor Birniwa remarked that they would also interact with the P.O's where possible, ASUU, student unions, etc. with a view to getting further details on the needs of the University.

Responding, the Vice Chancellor Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, Mni, gave a brief history of the University and said that the University facilities could be improved with additional funding. Professor Rasheed hinted that the University needed money to rehabilitate students' hostel and lecture theaters, but serious intervention to solve the problem of electricity and water was needed.

Professor Rasheed assured the team that the University management would assist them with any vital information in the course of their assignment.

The Ag. Director DGA Meets With Staff

The Acting Director, Directorate of General Administration, Malam Muhammad Danlami Nasiru, held his first meeting with senior members of the Directorate on Tuesday 27th March, 2012 at the Staff Training Committee Room.

The Acting Director said the meeting was organized in order to brief members of staff on the new directorate structure in the Registry Department.

Malam M. D. Nasir stated that the restructuring was done as a result of the Professor Abubakar Rasheed's promise during a parley in July 2010, that if appointed as the Vice Chancellor, he would restructure some key departments and units in the University.

The Ag. Director explained that the Vice Chancellor, upon assumption into office constituted a committee that would restructure the Registry Department for effective service delivery.

He hinted that the committee, which was set up under the chairmanship of Professor Sa'idu Babura Ahmad, visited some 1st, 2nd and 3rd generation Universities and after due consultations, recommended to the Vice Chancellor how the new

Registry Department should be restructured.

The former Establishment Secretary said that the Directorate of General Administration involved three main Divisions, the Council Affairs, Faculties/Units and the Publications and Documentation Division.

Malam Nasir added that the Council Affairs was responsible for all matters affecting the University Council, including coordinating activities of the council and its committees.

The Ag. Director noted that the Faculties/Units would coordinate and monitor the day-to-day activities of the Administrative Officers in the Faculties, Centres and Units of the University, while the Publications and Documentation Division would be responsible for the University publications, particularly the Weekly and Special Bulletins, internal press releases and advertisement, documentation of the University publications, the issuance of ISBN/ISSN, as may be directed by the Registrar and the maintenance of legal deposits with the National Library.

Malam Nasir enjoined staff members to prove that the restructuring was a better option by putting in their best in order to add value to the system.
