# BUK TOPS NIGERIAN Universities

# Gets Full NUC Accreditation Valid For 7 Years

ayero University, Kano has once again written its name in gold in the annals of University education by retaining its top spot among the Nigerian Universities, as the National Universities Commission (NUC) released the result of its 2011 Institutional Accreditation of Nigerian Universities.

The National Universities Commission (NUC), which conducted the Institutional Accreditation in various Universities in Nigeria late last year, visited the University from 27<sup>th</sup> November to 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2011 and conducted the exercise.



In a letter containing the result of the exercise, the NUC Executive Secretary, Professor Julius Okojie said based on the exercise conducted across the Universities, Bayero University, Kano scored 71.10% with full accreditation which is valid for 7 years.

Professor Okojie congratulated the University for recording yet another milestone in University education in Nigeria.

It should be noted that during the November/December NUC Institutional Accreditation Exercise in Nigerian Universities. the Commission evaluated institutional vision, mission and strategic goals; institutional governance and administration, resources, quality of teaching/learning and research: institutional efficiency, extension services and consultancies. transparency, financial management and stability, as well as general ethos.

Bayero University was able to get 71.10% full accreditation status.

# 4800QualifiedforMedicine,Only100GivenAdmission- VC

Over four thousand eight hundred (4800) applicants passed the requirements and were eligible for the Medicine programme in Bayero University this year, but only 100 were successful, as the University duly complied with the NUC carrying capacity of only 100 students, the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed has said.

Speaking on Tuesday when the Zakat and Hubusi Commission, led by its Chairman. Sheikh Usman Yusuf Makwarari, came to commiserate with the University over the recent attacks, Professor Rasheed asserted that the Medicine program in BUK remained the best in Nigeria, as it consistently complied with the standard regulations the National of Universities Commission (NUC) and the Nigerian Medical Association (NMA).

The Vice-Chancellor expressed confidence that the University's Medicine programme would continue to be a force to reckon with in Nigeria, as the University has mapped out veritable strategies to expand and reinvigorate it.

On the commission's mission, Professor Rasheed expressed appreciation over the condolence visit and advised it to award scholarships to indigent female students to study medicine in order to produce more female Doctors in Kano.

Earlier, the Commissioner 1 of the Commission, Imam Hafiz Sani Abdullahi, who spoke on behalf of the



Chairman, Usman Yusuf Makwarari, prayed to God to protect the entire University community against any unfortunate attack and prayed for lasting peace to thrive.

Malam Yusuf Makwarari appealed to the University management to consider giving the commission some used items in order to distribute same to the indigent people in the society.
