She said in spite of the giant strides in library automation the team was highly impressed with current journals and books published in 2012.

In terms of staff strength, the leader of the team showered strong commendation over the availability of 50% of Professors in all the programmes. "I am highly pleased with the brand new blocks for the Education Faculty of and overwhelmed by the conducive atmosphere of classrooms and laboratories. This shows that the laboratories are highly used by the students", she added.

B. 3011, KANO-NIGERIA Prof. Obinaju, who is from the University of Uyo, Akwa Ibom State observed that there was a need for designing a curriculum for each programme separately and more fire extinguishers should be installed.

Receiving the summary of the report for observation, the representative of Vice Chancellor, said as a result of University's Bayero continuous excellent rating from the NUC, students from all walks of life apply to the University for admission yearly. He appealed to the NUC to collaborate with the Federal Government to increase funding to Universities with good accreditation status.

The Deputy Vice Chancellor, Administration, Professor Sadiq Isah Radda, said that accreditation always serves as a booster to the University. He said in the next couple of months, several developmental projects would take-off in the University.

On the first day of the exercise on Monday 8th October, 2012, the NUC team led by Professor Obinaju paid a courtesy call on the Vice Chancellor and told him that the team's mission was a peer review process, whereby programmes in Education Arts, such as Education/Arabic, Islamic Studies and Hausa, would be assessed. The team leader expressed optimism that after the team completed its assignment, a good report would be sent to the NUC.

Responding, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, MFR, mni, told the team that Bayero University had in recent times seen several transformations in physical and academic programmes. He said with the approval of new programmes the University would soon have 13 Faculties, in place of the nine at present.

The Vice Chancellor stressed that arrangements had reached an advanced stage for the take-off of a College of Medicine that would house the faculties of Allied Health, Dentistry, Clinical Science and Basic Medical Science.

Prof. Rasheed remarked that the Faculty of Education is one of the strongest faculties in BUK and with the expansion of facilities, it would soon move to its new ultra-modern building.

According to the Vice Chancellor, "all programames in Bayero University enjoy full accreditation status from the N.U.C. and which in its recent Institutional Accreditation placed Bayero University among the eight 'A' rated Universities in Nigeria."

It would be recalled that in the November 2006 accreditation exercise, Bayero University got 66.7% Full Accreditation with no denied status in any programme, which was later approved by the Board of NUC in its meeting held on Wednesday 10th January, 2007.

The Vice Chancellor disclosed this when members of the National

Universities Commission (NUC) accreditation panel visited his office on Monday 8th October, 2012. He said the projects included the multi-billion naira seven storey Centre of Excellence, an ultra-modern five storey Senate Building and many others.

He said the Library had strengthened its automation services, as the University has recently spent \$200,000 in the purchase of electronic journals in different areas. He said students could now access over 11 million books.

The Vice Chancellor added that with the transformation of the e-library, students in the next 6 months would start receiving books in their e-mails.

The IIIBF 7thSeminar Report:IslamicBankingThroughConventional Infrastructure

At the 7th seminar series of the Institute, a paper titled "Challenges for Establishing Islamic Bank through Islamizing Conventional Infrastructure in Nigeria" was presented by the Assistant Director (Program) of the institute, Dr. Mansur Idris, on 4th October, 2012.

The paper reviewed the concept of Islamic financial institutions and showed that thev are non-interest banks transacting business and engaging in trading, investment and commercial activities, as well as the provision of financial products and services in accordance with Shari'ah principles and rules of Islamic commercial the jurisprudence.

The paper argued that, for an effective Islamic financial system in the form of full-fledged Islamic bank and Islamic window to exist, there is the need to modify our financial infrastructures. These include conventional banks. insurance sector, financial products, systems, regulations, payment standards and financial accounting training. The modification of these structures should be done in such a manner as to fully recognize and accommodate the specificities and peculiarities of Islamic institutions.
