## Transformation of Faculty of Engineering into a Centre of Excellence Commences

n its continued drive to upgrade physical infrastructures and academic programmes, the management of Bayero University has started to transform the Faculty of Engineering into a strategic center of excellence.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, MFR, mni disclosed this while receiving the President of the Nigerian Society of Engineers (NSE), Engineer Mustapha B. Shehu, and other executive members during a courtesy call on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2012.

Represented by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academic, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, the Vice Chancellor stressed that due to the importance given to Engineering, the University recently procured and installed modern equipment worth over  $\mathbb{N}800$  Million Naira for the laboratories and studio. He said the Faculty would soon be expanded to occupy the buildings of the Departments of Mass Communication, History and Islamic Studies, as they would be moved to other new buildings.

Prof. Rasheed emphasized that in its efforts to make the Faculty one of the best in Nigeria, the University would programmes soon start on Communication Engineering. Mechatronics. Petroleum and Chemical Engineering as the Senate has approved them. He added that in recent recruitment four lecturers of Mechatronics have been sent to foreign countries for MSc and PhD.

Earlier. the President NSE. of Engineer Shehu, said the Society was in Kano for a memorandum of understanding with а nongovernmental organization on the fight against desert encroachment. He said the memorandum would also create a Trans-Saharan highway that would facilitate commercial and economic activities.

The President expressed appreciation over the support given to the NSE by the University and promised to
