Texila American Varsity Wants Student Exchange Programme with BUK

The Texila American University (TAU) has written a letter to the University through the Registrar, Sani Ibrahim Amin, seeking for student exchange and credit transfer programme linkage with BUK.

The TAU which is located in Guyana, the only English speaking country in South America, "offers health science programmes with a high level of professionalism, exactness and problem solving skills, which facilitates further education and development of graduates' knowledge throughout their lives".

The Student Affairs Officer for Regional Office, Nigeria, Mr.Jamiu Sekoni-Dairo, said the Regional Office assists interested students and parents willing to study in TAU "for smooth admission processing, transfer system and traveling arrangement", as well as works closely with government regulatory bodies in Nigeria.

"The University Governing Council has granted the Nigeria Regional Officer request to allow core Science related 400 Level students from partner Nigerian Universities to transfer their credit into our 4-year Doctor of Medicine and Dentistry. Students can also transfer their 3-year Bachelor of Nursing", he said.

The Student Affairs Officer added that these programmes are specifically designed for students willing to make a career in Medicine, Dentistry and Nursing. Qualified students he said would be allowed into direct Doctor of Medicine or Dentistry or a 3-year Bachelor of Nursing (BSc Nursing).

Mr. Dairo explained that "the TAU is affiliated to 5 teaching hospitals in the United States. Medical students who are willing to spend their last two years of Clinical Rotation in the United States or India can do so. Nursing students who are willing to spend their last two years in the United Kingdom can do so through our partner University-West England University, UK. Job placement is also available after graduation in various countries through the University Advancement Centre".

The Student Affairs Officer noted that Texila American University is willing to have discussion with relevant University officials regarding this program.
