BUK to Partner With Saudi Varsities On Science & Technology

Bayero University has stated its determination to partner with Universities in Saudi Arabia in the area of science, technology and staff exchange with the mediation of its Consulate in Nigeria.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, *mni*, MFR made the proposal to the Consul General of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in Nigeria, His Excellency, Majid Muhammad Al-khatani when he paid a courtesy call to the VC on Wednesday, 24th April, 2013.

Prof. Rasheed affirmed the University's readiness to fast track the academic linkage, which he said would go a long way in rejuvenating the existing cordial

relationship between Nigeria and Saudi Arabia.

The Vice Chancellor further expressed appreciation and pleasure over Saudi Arabia's recent transformation and advancement in science and technology education.

On his part, the Consul General, His Excellency Majid Muhammad A1khatani, said the Saudi government has been making concerted efforts to advance the frontiers of knowledge through the creation of Universities. He said that the Saudi Government has committed a significant amount of monev to University education with a total endowment of \$1billion (\frac{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{billion}}}}}}.

His Excellency Majid Muhammad Alkhatani, while briefing the Vice Chancellor about the 25 Universities in Saudi, also remarked that the graduates participate actively in nation building projects all over the Kingdom.

He expressed his Consulate's readiness to mediate academic linkage with Saudi Arabian Universities.

The Consul General was taken round some of the University's physical projects, including the Senate Building, the Centre for Excellence and the Centre for Qur'anic Studies.



BUK, Utara Uni. Malaysia Set To Establish an Institute of Afri-Asian Studies

An Institute of African-Asian Studies that will focus on research, is to be set up as a joint collaboration between Bayero University, Kano and Utara University, Malaysia (UUM).

Speaking during an interactive session between the Institute of Islamic Banking and Finance (IIIBF) and the Dean of School of Accountancy, UUM, Professor Kamil M. D. Idris, at the Senate Chambers on Wednesday, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed, mni, MFR, said establishing the Institute would allow for exploring the many areas of research issues on African and further strengthen the bilateral Nigeria relationship between and Malaysia.

Prof. Rasheed recalled that BUK was the first University in Nigeria to sign academic linkage with Utara University. He particularly praised the linkman, Professor Kabir Dandago's emphatic diligence in trying to facilitate collaboration between IIIBF and Islamic Business School, Malaysia.

On his part, Professor Kamil Idris assured the University that Utara University would do everything possible to ensure that the collaboration is signed very soon.

Prof. Idris noted that his University had already established an Islamic Business

School to regulate Islamic accounting standards, "and it is high time to champion the cause of an international Islamic economics standard."

Showering his encomiums, Professor Kabir Dandago, who is currently a visiting lecturer to Utara University, advised that the Institute should be domiciled in BUK and funded by the two Universities.

The Director, IIIBF, Professor Shehu Rano, also briefed the visitors about the role and functions of the Institute.

After a documentary film on Utara University was played the Vice Chancellor mandated the Director IIIBF, Professor Shehu Rano, to design a staff training, blue-print and a memorandum of understanding, which will allow BUK staff to acquire a PhD at Utara, after doing their course work in Nigeria, with a two or three-week spell in the Asian country.

Professor Rasheed who was represented Chancellor the Deputy Vice bv (Academics), Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello said the profession they have chosen entailed a great deal of dedication, patience sacrifice. and perseverance.

The Vice Chancellor said by their induction today, they are qualified to practice as Medical Doctors, adding, "the University would expect nothing from you other than to be its good ambassadors wherever you find yourself."

An indigent student is a scholar who is in a poor financial standing and needs the sponsorship of someone other than his parent or guardian.

2) Criteria for the Award:

- a. The beneficiary should be a Nigerian.
- b. He should be a registered undergraduate student of Bayero University, Kano.
- c. He should be an indigent student verified through a rigorous process of the Faculty Committee.
- d. The award shall be for one academic session only. However, awardees can reapply in a new session later.
- e. The award shall terminate if the awardee was found to be involved in cultism, examination misconduct or any conduct that contravenes the University Regulations, as enshrined in the Student's Handbook.

3) Value of the Award:

An awardee is entitled to the amount of Thirty Thousand Naira (№30,000.00) per session.
