

Dissolution of the MIS Unit & Reorganization of Students & Staff Records Systems

At its last meeting, the University Management Committee considered the memo from the Vice Chancellor on the need to harmonize students and staff records system to improve efficiency, avoid duplications and generate data whenever needed. Accordingly, the UMC approved the dissolution of the Management Information System (MIS) unit and the transfer of its three core functions as follows:

- i. Management of Student Records/Information to the *Directorate of Academic Affairs of the Registry*.
- ii. Management of Staff Records/Information to the *Directorate of Personnel Affairs of the Registry*.
- iii. The Technical Services being provided by MIS to the *Centre of Information Technology (CIT)* as appropriate.

In view of the new roles to be handled by both the Directorates of Academic and Personnel Affairs, the University Management Committee further approved **renaming** of the two Directorates as follows:

- i. The Directorate of Academic Affairs (DAA) to Directorate of Examinations, Admissions and Records (DEAR);
- ii. The Directorate of Personnel Affairs (DPA) to Directorate of Establishment Matters (DEM).

The effective date of implementing the reorganization is 1st October, 2013. The processes of transfers should therefore be completed before then.



All affected staff are requested to comply accordingly, a circular signed by the Secretary, University Management Committee, Alhaji M. S. Aminu directed.

Muslims Should Uphold Lessons of Ramadan, Says Imam At Eid-el-Fitr Prayer

The Bayero University Muslim community joined hundreds of thousands of other Muslims in the country on Thursday, 8th July,2013 equivalent to the 1st of Shawwal 1436 in celebration of Eid-el-fitr which marked the end of the one month fasting period, observed by Muslims across the world, as one of the pillars of Islam.

Sheikh Abubakar Jibril, the Chief Imam of the Old Campus mosque who led the prayer, in his sermon while commending Muslims for their steadfastness especially during the period, gave praises to the Almighty for His Infinite Mercy to mankind at all times.

He reminded Muslims to continue to hold on to the virtues Ramadan taught them such as patience, self restrain, having harmonious relationship with one another, assisting the poor and constant recitation of the Holy Qur'an.

Sheikh Jibril, advised husbands to be more loving and caring and show high degree of understanding and patience to their wives at any point in time and whenever they might have erred, as the task of maintaining the family as he puts it, "is not an easy one."

Similarly, in his sermon, the Chief Imam of BUK New Campus mosque, Professor Muhammad Auwal Abubakar underscored the importance of the Eid-elfitr, which he said it is the day to celebrate the end of the Ramadan fast.

The Imam tasked Muslims all over the world to reflect on their good deeds during the holy month of Ramadan throughout the year and stressed the need for them to put into practice the teachings and preaching conducted by Islamic clerics.
