### **Staff School Wears a New Look**

Efforts to improve all facilities in the Staff Model Secondary School by the management, the Parents Teachers Association and successive Governing Boards have tremendously transformed the institution, giving it a new outlook expected to improve the learning process.

The Principal of the School, Mallam Tijjani Muhammad Adamu, who made the observation was full of praises to all the bodies concerned for the cooperation and assistance it has been receiving, especially in the ongoing renovation of classrooms, laboratories, the school library, toilets and offices, in addition to the financial and moral support offered by parents at all times.

Mallam Tijjani said the current transformation of the school started with Professor Fatima M. Umar when she became the Chairperson of the Governing Board. It continued when she was succeeded by Professor Sadiq Isah Radda, the then Dean, School of Post-Graduate Studies and currently the Deputy Vice Chancellor

(Administration). The incumbent Chairman, Professor Jibrin Hamman Yola, of the Islamic Studies Department has built on their work to fruition.

He said about ₦10m was expended from the internally generated revenue, through a development levy of twelve thousand Naira paid by each parent.

According to him, the exercise has boosted students and teachers' morale in teaching and learning process, as teaching-aids that motivate learning such as white boards, a well equipped library, new furniture, ceiling fans and a standby generator have now been put in place.

The Principal said the management has come up with various clubs in the school such as Young Farmers, Voters' Education, Press, Muslim Students Society and JETS clubs as extra-circular activities. To sensitize the students to learn faster, more efficient guidance and counseling lessons are given in addition to extra lessons. The support and efforts of both parents and teachers as well as the governing board are meant to raise educational standards.

The school has an enrolment of about 600 students with 70% success in the 2012/2013 SSCE results.

### **Agric Econ's Ibrahim Chigari Loses Father**
