PLANS FOR 2013/2014 REGISTRATION EXERCISE

The Directorate of Examinations, Admissions and Records would like to draw the attention of students to the following plans for registration for the 2013/2014 Session. Students should take note of the plans and abide by them.

Registration Procedure: The registration procedure has not changed. A student is to login to <u>myBUK</u> portal, print his/her personalized Payment Invoice, pay the <u>exact amount</u> at any of the designated banks, then login to the portal again to register for the courses. A student who pays an amount different from what is on the Invoice would not be able to continue!

Registration Timetable: The following timetable will be strictly enforced:
