Use Your Training to Impact Positively on Students - Registrar Tells Technologists

The Registrar, Sani Ibrahim Amin *MNIM*, has charged Technologists who have undergone an in-house training organized by the Human Resource Unit to use what they learned in guiding students in practicals, in line with best practices, so that they will graduate as competent and competitive products.
