NUC Approves 21 Part-Time **Degree Programmes for BUK**

The National Universities Commission (NUC) has approved the establishment of 21 part- time degree programmes for Bayero University, effective from 2014/2015 academic session.

 2^{nd} A letter dated October, 2014 with NUC/DESO/F07/VOL.1/5 No. reference signed by Dr G. B. Kumo, Director, Academic Standards Department of the National Universities Commission stated that all the programmes should bear only the approved titles and nomenclatures as such any change requires re-approval of the Commission.

According to the statement, the Nursing Science programme has at least three months of uninterrupted practices. The Commission had enjoined the university to provide adequate human and material resources for development and growth the of the programmes.
