PENSION UNIT:

Calling All Employees Due For Retirement between January and December 2018 under the Contributory Pension Scheme

n line with the provision of section 15 of the Officers (Bayero University, Kano staff) who attain Pension Reform Act, 2014 and as part of the Limplementation process of the issuance of Federal Government Retirement Bond, the National Pension Commission plans to organize a pre-retirement verification and enrolment exercise for employees in the service of the Federal Government of Nigeria Treasury funded Ministries, Departments and Agencies that are due to retire between January and December 2018 by virtue of attaining 65 years of age for teaching and non teaching or 70 years of age (Professors only) for employees of Tertiary Institutions, a statement by the Secretary Pension Unit, Muhammad Bello Garba said.

The exercise would also cover employees who had retired voluntarily/mandatorily but are yet to be enrolled by the pension commission, the statement added.

65 years of age, Teaching and Non-Teaching and Professors who attain 70 years of age between January and December 2018 are requested to forward their names to the Registrar on or before Tuesday, February 28, 2017.

Officers who also wish to voluntarily retire can also forward their names.

Affected staff should attach photocopies of the underlisted document to their notification letters. They should also submit same to the Pension Secretary, Muhammad Bello Garba:

Health Advices on Typhoid Fever Prevention

- Wash your hands. Frequent hand-washing in hot, soapy water is the best way to control treatment.
 Wash before eating or preparing food and after using the toilet. Carry an alcohol-based hand sanitizer for times when water isn't available.
- Boil your drinking water for 15 minutes when you suspect contamination.
- Take only wholesome milk, yoghurt, canned or bottled milks and avoid un-wholesome ones that are more prone to contamination.
- Avoid un-covered food from street vendors as it is more likely to be contaminated.
- Always insist on warm foods that are stored and served in a covered form.

- Ensure proper washing of vegetables and fruits with salt and clean water before consumption.
- Ensure proper storage and preservation of perishable foods items, as perishable foods are more likely to be easily contaminated.
- Buy your food from regulated food premises (i.e commercial or non-commercial places that meet all the sanitary requirements to operate food services).
- Ensure proper cleansing and storage of kitchen utensils and other food containers, to avoid possible contamination.
- Ensure thorough cooking of meat.

Nursing Science must have credits in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

- Step 5 An auto-generated acknowledgement Slip will be sent immediately into applicant's mail box. Print the Slip and keep it safe. The Slip will be needed during the collection of Admission Letter and During Registration.
