We'll Turn BUK into a Centre for Technological Innovation - Prof. Akinwande By Bala G. Abdullahi

Professor of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science in Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA, Professor Akintunde Ibitayo Akinwande, has pledged to work with Bayero University to turn the institution into a Centre for Technological Innovation.

Professor Akinwande was speaking during a courtesy call on the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, on Tuesday, 29th January, 2019, when he observed that technology had succeeded in transforming positively every sphere of human endeavours and, as such, efforts should be made to promote the teaching of the course.

He said that was why through Empowering The Teachers'(ETT) programme in which excellence in

awareness regarding the Empowering The Teachers' (ETT) programme, which he promoted, but was sponsored by two multinational oil corporations-Total Nigeria, Plc and the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation (NNPC).

According to Professor Akinwande, he had earlier visited Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, for a similar programme and now they are in Bayero University to hold three sessions: Discussion with the Deanery of the Faculty of Engineering, a technical session on Empowering The Teachers' (ETT) programme and promoting excellent teaching and research and lastly, a technical seminar: titled 'Feedback on the Draft Curriculum for Electrical Engineering/Building



teaching and research are promoted through sponsorship training, they intended to work with Bayero University to produce the manpower that could achieve technological innovation.

Professor Akinwande added that, looking closely at the level of successes recorded by BUK in the area of academic exploits, coupled with the realization that universities had a great role to play in leading in the use of technology to transform our society, it might not be out of place to work with the institution in order to turn it into a world class Centre for Technological Innovation in order to achieve the desired objectives.

The MIT Professor was in Bayero University to interact with its academic staff as part of efforts to create


Capacity in Nanotechnology.'

Responding, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Bello, thanked Professor Akinwande and members of his team for choosing Bayero University to hold the technical sessions there. He also commended him for championing this very important Empowering The Teachers' programme, which, he said, was in tandem with BUK's philosophy.

He assured that Bayero University would continue to prioritize capacity building through conference attendances as a deliberate effort to encourage academic staff to up-date their knowledge in line with modern trends. for the Forum's library were purchased and installed at the cost of N 250,000.00.

The *Ameer* also outlined some other achievements of the Forum during the year, which included Annual Ramadan Lecture, providing financial support to some indigent students and successful review of the constitution of the Forum, which was presented at the meeting.

Commissioning the library and the renovated Nasiha stores located beside Old Campus Central Mosque, the Chairman of the *Shura* Committee, Professor Ahmed Rufa'i Mohammed, highly praised the Forum for the

projects.

On his part, the Deputy Vice Chancellor Academics, Professor Adamu Idris Tanko, prayed for the success of the projects and commended the University staff that were providing monthly contributions for the activities of the Forum. He also praised those of the University Mosques Management Committee.

He, therefore, called on the University Community to make the best use of the library and the stores, which are meant to further serve the community at competitive rates.
