BUK Hosts Kano By Nura Garba Gubernatorial Debate

ayero University, Kano hosted a Gubernatorial Debate on Saturday, 2nd February, 2019. The debate was organized by the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC), Hausa Service, for governorship candidates in Kano State.

Abba Kabir Yusuf of PDP, Mustapha Getso, (NPM), Salihu Sagir Takai, (PRP) and Maimuna Muhammad of UPP participated in the debate, which was moderated by the BBC's veteran journalist, Ibrahim Isa.

When asked about their plan on what to do in their first 100 days in office, if elected, the candidates responded confidently to the raptures of the audience that came from different sections of the society, consisting of journalists, civil society organizations, students, civil servants, business men and women, artistes and members of Bayero University Community as well as the general public.

Alhaji Mustapha Getso of NPM said his major focus would be on youth development, economic development, health, education and improvement of security in the state.

In his response the PRP Gubernatorial Candidate, Malam Salihu Sagir Takai, said it was difficult to bring programmes that will satisfy the people of Kano State in just 100 days, but, "I will try as much as possible to enhance good governance and security situations in the state, as well as improve the health and education sectors."

On her own part, Maimuna Muhammad of UPP

revealed that the major concern of her administration would be the emancipation of women folk, decongestion of public schools, abolishing of political thuggery and consideration of people with special

needs as part of her development agenda for the state.

When asked on how to improve the dilapidated education sector in the state if elected, Salihu Takai explained that the problem would be tackled from the grassroots through training and retraining of teachers, providing essential tools and collaborating with parents in order to monitor the progress of their wards.

Maimuna Muhammad emphasized that she would try as much as possible to decongest the already overcrowded classrooms and improve the welfare of teachers in public schools.

The PDP Candidate, Abba Kabir Yusuf said he would continue with the initiative of sponsoring the best performing students to study various programmes in some selected universities abroad and that they would be automatically employed when they return. This is in addition to other laudable socio-economic programmes, he added.

Disagreeing with the submission of other candidates, Mustapha Getso argued that the best way out was to improve the standard of education locally so that students will not be sponsored in any university abroad. He said if the schools were improved, coupled with the welfare of teachers and provision of houses, it would discourage the wealthy individuals from taking their families abroad to study.

The candidates spoke separately on how to tackle the dilapidated economy, street begging, unemployment, illicit drug abuse, among others.
