
Council Approves 36 Professors, 40 Associate Professors By Lamara Garba By Lamara Garba

BUK Wins N100mBy Nura Garba TRIMING Research Grant

Bayero University Centre for Dryland Agriculture in collaboration with the International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT) and National Space Research and Development Agency (NASRDA) has won a three hundred and twenty-seven thousand, two hundred and sixty-three dollars ninety-two cents \$327,263,92 (about N100m) Transforming Irrigation Management in Nigeria (TRIMING) research grant.

TRIMING is a World Bank project with counterpart funding under the Ministry of Water Resources. The objective of the project is to improve access to irrigation and drainage services and to strengthen institutional arrangements for integrated water resources management and agriculture service delivery

in selected large-scale public schemes in Northern Nigeria which include: Bakolori Irrigation Scheme (BIS); Dadin Kowa Irrigation Scheme (DIS); Hadejia



Valley Irrigation Scheme (HVIS); Kano River Irrigation Scheme (KRIS) and Middle River Valley

Irrigation Scheme (MRVIS).

Bayero University as the lead institute, on behalf of other collaborators, signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) on 7th March, 2019 for the implementation of an Innovative Action Research in Kano River Irrigation Scheme titled: Participatory Soil Salinity/Sodicity Management for Sustainable Crop Productivity under Irrigation and Improved Livelihood in Kano River Irrigation Project.

Present at the MoA signing were the National Project Coordinator of TRIMIMNG, Engineer Peter Yakubu Manjuk and his team from Federal Ministry of Water Resources; BUK team led by Director, Academic Planning, Professor Bala Sidi Aliyu and a team of researchers; Research Panel of Experts (RPoE) led by Prof. Henry E. Igbadun and the Director, CDA, Professor Jibrin M. Jibrin.

BUK Welcomes COREN Accreditation for Quality Programmes - VC By Mustapha Gide

Bayero University is strictly adhering to the guidelines of COREN, NUC and other professional associations with the hope of becoming one of the best universities in Africa and globally, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, has disclosed.

While receiving COREN accreditation team on Monday, 11th March, 2019, Professor Bello, who was represented by the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Administration), Professor Haruna Wakili, said the University's collegiate system, training and retraining as well as equipping its laboratories were among the

Professor Bello told the accreditation team that the University perceived accreditation as a routine exercise that helps institutions to improve their facilities and programmes. He noted that Bayero University ran a transparent system for each accreditation team to scrutinize its facilities, records and any other thing.

Speaking earlier, the team leader, Engr. Felix O. Ebuzoeme, told the Vice Chancellor that the major mandate of COREN was quality assurance for

Nigerian universities to globally compete with their counterparts. He added that accreditation was for partnership and growth, aimed at building and not witch-hunting.

Engineer Ebuzoeme said that the products of any programme that had not been accredited would never be registered and, as such, universities and other tertiary institutions in the country should support the exercise, because at the end, it is Nigeria that will

The Vice Chancellor said the next step in the implementation of the collegiate system was creating an additional college for engineering-related programmes; that was why some programmes like B. Eng. Petro-Chemical Engineering and B. Eng.
