All Hands Must Be on Deck to Fight Moral Decadence in Our Society - Scholars

Scholars who gathered at this year's Ramadan Lecture held at Mahmud Tukur Theatre in Bayero University unanimously agreed that fighting moral decadence in our society requires the effort of all stakeholders, including parents, religious leaders, government, traditional institution and the media.

The Ramadhan Lecture was organized by Islamic Forum of Nigeria in conjunction with Freedom Radio, Rahama Radio, Africa TV3, IIIBF and IIITN, among others. The yearly lecture, which was themed **Moral Decadence in Our Society,** was the fourth in the series held on Saturday, 18th May, 2019.

Speaking at the occasion, Dr. Umar Sani Fagge deliberated on the causes of moral decadence in our society as well as the proposed remedies for the societal ill. He said one of the causes was the fact that people nowadays put their personal benefits ahead of their societal responsibilities.

Professor Hafiz Abubakar and Dr. Maikano Madaki, who spoke at the occassion said that to address the societal decadence all stakeholders must play an active role by taking a concrete step of action.

In his presentation, Dr. Aminu Sagagi of BUK's Islamic Studies and Shariah Department, highlighted that people nowadays are far away from the teachings of Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W), who carried out the gigantic and revolutionary task of changing his people to leave their *Jahiliyyah* trends. According to Dr. Aminu, there is moral decadence in our society today because people are returning to those *Jahiliyyah* practices. The solution, therefore, is to go back to the teachings of Islam such as those highlighted in *Suratul-Asr* of the Holy Qur'an for a candid cure.

The lecture attracted large gathering of scholars, traditional rulers, policy makers, institutions, students and the media.

An ultra-modern resource room for postgraduate students has been inaugurated at the Faculty of Engineering to ease teaching and research. The hall constitutes seats, tables, cabinets, an overhead projector and other accessories needed to make it comfortable for learning and research.

The Vice Chancellor, Prof Muhammad Yahuza Bello, while commissioning the facility on Tuesday, 21st May, 2019 described it as a modern building which had been equipped with improved facilities that would enable students to enhance their researches. The completion of the project was part of the determined efforts of the University to create conducive atmosphere and prioritize academic development" so as to enhance learning in the University, he explained.

He said it was the seventh postgraduate resource rooms constructed within various faculties of the University. Other faculties that already benefited from this gesture included Faculties of Communication, Education and Physical Sciences.

The Vice Chancellor urged the postgraduate students to take advantage of this opportunity and make maximum utilization of the facilities so as to complete their studies within the stipulated period of study. He admonished students for the judicious utilization of the hall and urged them not to misuse or vandalize the facilities therein.

Immediately after the commissioning, the Faculty of Engineering proceeded with a Postgraduate Orientation in the hall, where the Vice Chancellor delivered a lecture on the utilization of ICT for enhanced research and learning.

In understanding the importance of the nexus between capacity building and staff productivity, the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC) has showed its readiness to allow BUK to cope with the increased number of participants at the Advanced Digital Appreciation Programme for Tertiary Institutions (ADAPTI).

The Executive Vice Chairman of the NCC, Professor Umar Garba Dambatta, disclosed this while interacting with the participants during the closing ceremony of a five-day intensive training on *Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS) and the Use of Internet and Microsoft Office Productivity Tools (IOPT)*, organized by the Commission, on Friday, May 17, 2019 at the PTDF Hall, Old Campus.

The NCC Boss, who was represented by Engineer Haroun Alhassan said BUK had the opportunity to apply for facilities and more training of ADAPTI to be funded by the NCC.

According to Engr. Haroun, the objective of the 'ADAPTI' training was to equip teaching and non-teaching staff of universities in the country with practical skills in SPSS, Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point software applications as well as the use of Internet for improved productivity.

The University Librarian, Dr. Musa A. Auyo, who represented the Vice-Chancellor during the occasion, appreciated the organizers of the programme, who he described as bridge builders in the nation's tertiary education system. He thanked the participants for

making themselves available for one week to be trained and empowered. He emphasized that the University would ask for more facilities and training opportunities for enhanced teaching and research.

Dr. Auyo stressed that participants should take the training seriously and endeavour to translate the knowledge and skills acquired into practical teaching, research and administrative duties.

In his remarks, the Director of the Centre for Information Technology (CIT), Professor Muhammad Ajiya, explained that the NCC had been in support of the University for long, describing it as a partner in progress. He added that ADAPTI was conducted by the Digital Bridge Institute (DBI), a subsidiary of the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC).

The training focused on the proficient use of SPSS, the internet and Microsoft Office Productivity Tools for enhanced e-teaching and learning.

The training coordinator, Mr. Dashe Garba, explained

that the participants were equipped with the essential ICT skills through hands-on- training/learning approach, so that they could translate the acquired acknowledge and skills to improve teaching, research and work performance.

The ADAPTI capacity building training has been conducted in many public tertiary institutions in Nigeria and Bayero University was selected as one of the institutions to benefit from the free capacity building training programme organised by the NCC.

The NCC financed the programme and provided course materials to attendees as well as monitored the conduct of the training to encourage active participation by trainees for optimal outcomes in the University. Seventy teaching and forty non-teaching staff were selected from various departments to participate in the one week-long training. Each training was executed in form of five days of intensive exercise aimed at equipping beneficiaries to be able to apply the soft skills in their daily work.

BUK M.Sc/M.A PhD Graduands can out rightly purchase Academic Gown

Beginning from the 35th Convocation, Ph.D, M.Sc/M.A, MBA and M. Ent graduands of Bayero University can now outrightly purchase the academic gown, hood and cap.

Prospective buyers for Ph.D shall pay =N=17,000 while M.Sc, M.A, MBA and M.Ent shall pay =N=10,000 being the cost of gown, hood and cap through Remita platform. The set comes in three sizes of small (S), medium (M) and large (L). In addition, Ph.D, M.Sc, M.A, MBA or M.Ent graduands are to pay =N=8,000 for certificate, book of proceedings and scroll. Collection of paid academic

robes would be at the Bayero University Bookshop, New Campus, from Thursday 6th June, 2019.

Post Graduate Diploma Students can rent the gown at N5,000. Masters students are also at liberty to rent at the same cost. At the moment, only limited number of academic gowns are available at on a first come, first served basis. Post Graduate Diploma and Masters graduands who choose to hire will pay the total sum of N13,000 through Remita Platform (Cost of hire, convocation materials and certificates).
