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PR as Engine of National Integration ... NIPR President

The National President of the Nigeria Institute of Public Relations (NIPR), Alhaji Mukhtar Zubair Siraj has described public relations practitioners as engines of National Integration.

Speaking in Kano, on Saturday, 23rd November, 2019 at a graduation Dinner of the Master in Public Relations Class 2018/2019 at Chinese Palace Restaurant, Race Course, the NIPR President explained that the role of Public Relations cannot be over emphasized in the quest of National Unity and Development.

"Public Relations entails doing things the right way,

Earlier, during a panel of discussion, a former Kano State Police Command Public Relations Officer, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Alhaji Baba Mohammed said Public Relations Practitioners have a herculean task of bailing Nigeria out of the quagmire.

ACP Mohammed noted that a good Public Relations Officer is always articulated, and never played with the truth. "He always says the truth as it is, no more no less and must have a good human relation. You need not to hide the information," he added.

He also said a PR man is like the gateway to the



doing things in a civilized manner and putting things in a clear perspective, therefore, our role as public relations is to promote good governance, mutual understanding and national cohesion which will go a long way in promoting peace, unity and development", he declared.

Alhaji Mukthar lamented that many have wrong notion about public relation, pointing out that, if given free hands to operate, public relations can be of great value to our desire for economic, social and political development.

Also speaking, the Dean of the School of Postgraduate Studies, Professor Umaru A. Pate, while acknowledging the importance of Public Relations in Nation Building, advised the practitioners to have a paradigm shift. He said, the world has now become a global mechanical village in which everything has gone digital and that the earlier public relations practitioners adapt to the new system the better for them and the society.

organization, how you relate with people and the level of your honesty, truthfulness will determine how successful one can be.

The former Police spokes person also suggested that as a way of taming criminals, especially in the age of digitalization, public relations practitioners especially in the security circles must equally be digital and up to date in technology.

Also speaking, former Army spokesman, Brigadier General Usman Kuka-Sheka, revealed how rapid response in the wake of insurgency crisis charged the mind set of Nigerians to view to Boko Haram elements as mere criminals as against the earlier nation of fighting a religious war. He advised security agencies to use effective communication management to tackle insecurity in the country.

Accreditation Teams from the National Universities Commission (NUC) visited Bayero University, Kano on Thursday, 28th November, 2019 to evaluate postgraduate programmes in the Departments of Accounting and Business Administration.

The programmes being evaluated are: Masters in Treasury Management, Taxation and Revenue Administration, Accounting and Financial Management (Accounting) and Masters in Management and Business Administration, MBA (Business Administration).

Speaking on behalf of the two teams, Professor P.U. Akanwa told the Vice Chancellor that the best way to improve academic programmes is through NUC accreditation, saying that without accreditation the programmes would not have been the way they are now.

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, who received the teams along with the Registrar, Fatima Binta Isyaku Mohammed and the Bursar, Dr. Sulaiman Bello, said Bayero University gives much premium to accreditation exercise as it is a strategic

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello, who is also a fellow of the professional body, disclosed this while receiving officials of the association, who paid him a courtesy visit on Friday, 22nd November,

"We will be glad to host the MAN 2020 Conference because the last one that Bayero University hosted was in 1992" he stated.

The Vice Chancellor said BUK was endowed with venues of international standard to host conference of this nature, making reference to the Dangote Business School, Convocation Arena and the International Conference Centre, which, he said would be commissioned early next year.

Earlier, the President of the association, Professor Mamman Musa, revealed that the aim of their visit was to solicit the support of the University towards hosting the MAN Conference, which they tagged *Kano 2020*.

He said MAN usually visits hosting states to see facilities available and to seek support as part of its preparation for the conference.

Professor Mamman thanked the VC for his untiring support and described BUK as a fast growing university which, he said, was a testimony of good leadership.

The officials were led by the former Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academics), Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, who later took them for a tour within the University.

Nigerian Universities will soon commence offering degree programmes in Public Relations, Advertising and Broadcasting once the National Universities Commission (NUC) provides necessary guidelines for the implementation of the programme. This was made known by the Dean, School of Postgraduate Studies, Bayero University, Kano, Professor Umar Pate at a Conference and Dinner organized by the graduating Masters in Public Relation class 2018/2019 on Saturday, 23rd November, 2019.

Professor Pate who spoke on the unbundling of the Mass Communication programme, said most universities are waiting for further directives before implementation.

He said "The NUC after consultations with institutional stakeholders approved a curriculum for the unbundling of Mass Communication programme. The seven new programmes are; Journalism, Public Relations Advertising, Broadcasting, Film and Multimedia Studies, Development Communication Studies, Information and Media Studies.

He said the

Faculty needs additional facilities and manpower for the programmes.

Speaking on behalf of the graduating students, Baba Kandi, who is the Chairman Organizing Committee, expressed their happiness for the panelists who were all graduant of Mass Communication of BUK and also expressed appreciation to the faculty and the school management for the invaluable contributions given to them.

Restriction on Indiscriminate Bush Burning in Campus

Due to the current dry season, members of the University Community are hereby reminded to clear the grass/weeds in their vicinity to guard against fire outbreaks.

Members residing in the university's Campuses and Zoo Road Staff Quarters are required to caution their children/wards and house help against indiscriminate setting of fire either within the surrounding premises of their residences or surrounding bush. Parents should ensure that matches/lighters are kept out of reach of children. Staff are also reminded to ensure that they turn off all electrical appliances in their offices when closing from work for the day.

Members of the University Community are to please note that it is not permissible to use bush-burning as a means of clearing surrounding premises of residences or office blocks. However, small heaps of the trimmed dry grass can be cleared through burning within house premises when necessary and under strict supervision. Moreover, it must be ensured that the heaps burn off completely. Lighting fire and abandoning the site is not allowed. Any person that uses fire deliberately as a means of bush clearing thereby causing damage or loss to the University or individual's property as a result of his/her careless handling of the fire should note that in addition to any penalty that may be imposed by the University authority on him/her, shall be held liable and surcharged for the repairs of the damage or loss of property as the case may be. The Security Division implores members of the University Community to trim down and gather into heaps the dry grass/weeds and then notify the Sanitation Unit to clear them.
