he Times Higher Education (*THE*), of Britain, the United Kingdom in its 2023 World University assessment, has ranked Bayero University, Kano as number 1,016 in the Global Universities Ranking and 4<sup>th</sup> best in Nigeria.

According to the annual global ranking released on Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 over 2,500 universities across the world submitted data for assessment and ranking in which 97 universities were from Africa.

The Times Higher Education is one of the respected, largest and diverse university ranking organization in the world which assesses thousands of universities in over 104 countries.

About 25 universities from the African continent, including Bayero University, out of the 97 that submitted data got a ranking status in the competitive analysis while the remaining universities got "reporter" status only.

With its global ranking, BUK is now one of the best universities in Nigeria, coming behind University of Ibadan, University of Lagos and Covenant University as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> best respectively.

In addition to emerging 4<sup>th</sup> in the national ranking, Bayero University is also the best University in the entire North-West, North-Central, North-East, South-East and South-South regions.

The report said the ranking was based on 13 calibrated reputable journals and engage on more collaboration performance indicators that measure an institution's universities and industries at the international level.

he Times Higher Education (*THE*), of Britain, the performance across four areas of teaching, research, United Kingdom in its 2023 World University knowledge transfer and international outlook.

Bayero University was rated as Nigeria's overall best in terms of international outlook while it ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> best in the number of Students Full-Time Enrolment (SFTE) with over 44.4% score and was rated 3<sup>rd</sup> in research in the whole country.

In the global ranking, Oxford University was ranked as the overall best, followed by University of Harvard and University of Cambridge who emerged 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> best.

Reacting to the ranking, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, noted that this was a manifestation of the stakeholder's efforts at ensuring quality and standards as well as improving facilities for enhanced teaching and research.



## **INEC to Recruit BUK Staff, Students for 2023 General Electic**

Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) has planned to recruit staff and students of Bayero University, Kano for the 2023 general elections.

The electoral umpire has notified the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas on the need to mobilize the staff and students who are interested to register online using INECPRESS platform.

In a letter dated 30th September, 2022 signed by INEC's Administrative Secretary, Garba Lawal Muhammad and addressed to the Vice Chancellor, said "I am pleased to write and inform you that the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) has opened a portal for the recruitment of ad-hoc staff for the conduct of 2023 general elections."

The letter explained that the staff and students should register through INECPRESS which is available through the link on INEC website at www.inecnigeria.org (a link for the mobile app and other links are for the web portal. It added that the URL of the registration web portal is https://pres.inecnigeria.org while the downloaded link for the INECPRES mobile app installer (android phones only) is https://inecpress.app.com/press.

According to the letter, all applicants are encouraged to fill the registration form online to be eligible for consideration as ad-hoc staff.
