The objective of the workshop according to Professor D.J.U Kalla is to build capacity of academic staff in public institutions on proposal writing and grant management.

Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, who declared the workshop open on Wednesday, 22nd March, 2023 at the Conference Room of Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA), said the workshop would assist in developing the capacity of staff of the University to develop, prepare and submit quality research proposals to funding organizations.

The Vice Chancellor, who was represented by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, (Academics), Professor Mohammed Sani Gumel, said Bayero University has been undergoing transformations in terms of its structure, number and quality of research projects, as well as engagement with development partners. He said

tremendous strides were initiated and sustained by successive university administrations to transform the University into a research based institution.

The Vice Chancellor added that the development of research-based policies and the establishment of multi-disciplinary research centres is a response to this initiative. He further expressed the hope that the workshop would be a great success, hoping that the participants would come out more informed and be able to successfully write good and qualitative proposals for competitive grant.
